

**Village of Loomis
Budget Hearing Minutes
September 14th, 2021 - Following Budget Discussion Meeting
Loomis Community Building**

The Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Loomis held a Budget Hearing on September 14, 2021. Notice of the Budget Hearing Meeting was published in the Holdrege Daily Citizen on September 8, 2021. Board members present included: Mike Thorell, Maxine Berry, Ben Collin, Melanie Freeman, and Don Masten. There were no board members absent.

The Budget Hearing was opened at 7:11PM. Three copies of the proposed budget statement were available to the public.

Motion by Don Masten and seconded by Melanie Freeman to approve Resolution 0921-01. Voting Ayes: Thorell, Berry, Collin, Freeman, Masten. Voting Nays: None. Motion passed 5/0.

RESOLUTION NO. 0921-1

WHEREAS, Nebraska Revised Statute 77-1601.02 provides that Governing Body of the Village of Loomis passes by a majority vote a resolution or ordinance setting the tax request; and

WHEREAS, a special public hearing was held as required by law to hear and consider comments concerning the property tax request;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governing Body of the Village of Loomis, resolves that:

- 1. The 2021-2022 property tax request be set at \$115,201.00.**
- 2. The total assessed value of property differs from last year's total assessed value by 1.11%.**
- 3. The tax rate which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last year, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of property, would be \$0.37292 per \$100 of assessed value.**
- 4. The Village of Loomis proposes to adopt a property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be \$0.377076 per \$100 of assessed value.**
- 5. Based on the proposed property tax request and changes in other revenue, the total operating budget of the Village of Loomis is greater than last year's by 51.97%.**
- 6. A copy of this resolution be certified and forwarded to the County Clerk on or before October 13, 2021.**

Motion by Ben Collin and seconded by Maxine Berry to close the Budget Hearing. Voting Ayes: Thorell, Berry, Collin, Freeman, Masten. Voting Nays: None. Motion passed 5/0.

The Budget Hearing was closed at 7:13PM.
